From MD: Right after the American Legion Bridge on the 495 beltway, take exit (43) 44 toward Georgetown Pike and GW Parkway. Go onto the long exit ramp; do not go right onto the GW Parkway which branches off the same exit (43); do not stay in the left lane or you will go out onto the beltway again. After passing GW Pkwy exit (43), get in the right-hand lane => exit 44 going up to the light at the top of the ramp. You'll see it; it's not hard. Turn right onto 193 West toward Great Falls. Drive 7.3 miles to the library. Eventually you'll pass through the light at Old Dominion Rd. Shortly after Innsbruck Ave. (and immediately after Bucks Lane), turn right into the library parking lot. You will see the library, red brick building with a green roof. The green library sign is a little past the library, so if you miss the turn, just turn right at the light at Walker Road, turn around in the parking lot of the yellow building (also with a green roof), and come back. Note: there's a little shopping center across from the library.

From VA: Take the 495 Beltway exit 44 to Georgetown Pike toward Great Falls. After exiting the beltway, merely turn left at the light onto Route 193 West toward Great Falls. Drive 7.3 miles to the library. Eventually you'll pass through the light at Old Dominion Rd. Shortly after Innsbruck Ave. (and immediately after Bucks Lane), turn right into the library parking lot. You will see the library, red brick building with a green roof. The green library sign is a little past the library, so if you miss the turn, just turn right at the light at Walker Road, turn around in the parking lot of the yellow building (also with a green roof), and come back. Note: there's a little shopping center across from the library. (I'm sure there are other ways to get there from VA, so you Virginia folks--use your maps if you'd like to choose another route, perhaps Route 7, Walker Rd, or Old Dominion, etc.).

Remember you are going toward Great Falls (W), not Langley (E). Georgetown Pike is a fairly long, 7.3-mile, two-lane, winding-but-well-paved road, a straight shot to the library. It takes exactly 10 minutes once you turn onto 193. There are lots of trees and beautiful homes. Just take your time and enjoy the scenery.
