Directions:

From central PA or I-476:

1. Take I-276 East (PA Turnpike) to PHILADELPHIA exit (#351).
2. Immediately after paying toll, merge onto US1 North (left lane).
3. Follow US1 North to I-95 North. Merge onto I-95 North toward Trenton
4. Take I-95 North approximately 2.8 miles to EXIT 49 N (NEWTOWN/YARDLEY).
5. Stay in left lane of the exit ramp and turn left at top of ramp onto NEWTOWN/YARDLEY RD/PA-322 (also called the Newtown Bypass).
6. Stay on the NEWTOWN BYPASS for approximately 5 miles. You will cross Rtes. 413 and 532S.
7. The park entrance is at the intersection of Swamp Rd. and the 4 lane NEWTOWN BYPASS. You will make a left turn into the park. There is a sign for Tyler State Park on the traffic light at the intersection where you will turn left.

From Philadelphia, Delaware and South Jersey: Follow I-95 North to Exit 49 (Newtown/Yardley). Follow the above directions from Central PA; beginning at item #5

From New York and North Jersey: Follow the NJ turnpike to I-95 South to Exit 49 (Newtown/Yardley). At the top of the ramp merge right onto NEWTOWN/YARDLEY RD/PA-322 (also called the Newtown Bypass). Follow the above directions from Central PA; beginning at item #6.
